Dear Martin,

It is unfortunate that I find myself writing to you in an official capacity but it has come to the attention of ParticCorp that your employees, Luke Meyer on the neural mesh team and Jennifer Miller on the programming team, were spotted entering the ICU room of Jonathan Jaeger at Massachusetts General Hospital during the night of Wednesday, November 16 at approximately 22.30 hours.

I will send under separate cover both audio recording from Jonathan's ICU room and video footage from the hospital of Luke Meyer and Jennifer Miller entering the ICU room at the time stated above.

It is clear from the audio recording that they were stealing ParticCorp's proprietary code. This code is installed as a separate module to that of HaptAI's neural mesh. Therefore, HaptAI has no data or usage rights to the module or programming contained therein. Your employees downloaded the code directly from Jonathan's neural port on the back of his head. This could constitute physical assault and child endangerment. As Jonathan's guardian I will be considering whether or not to contact the police to press charges. ParticCorp are also considering their legal position with regard to the stolen code.

Fortunately, no harm came to Jonathan as he is unaware of the intrusion. In view of the crimes committed on an eight-year-old boy and ParticCorp, I must insist that these two HaptAI employees have their employment terminated immediately.
